

# Funding the specialty training in health centres

# Today

- **A public provider** (a single local municipality or joint authority) gets from the state about 1000 €/trainee/month compensating the work force loss of the trainee, because she/he is not treating patients, but attending education.

# The course of money

- In order to be accepted as a training health centre, the health centre must share that sum of money (75 % - 25 %) with the Primary Care Unit (PCU) of the local university hospital.
- PCU has a network covering its area for facilitating and assessing specialty training
- **The goals of training and the methods/content of training is set by university.**

# Problems

- Only public health centres are accepted
- The universities have the responsibility but no money at all

**Golden rule #2: He who has the gold sets the rules**

# Principles of course of money after SOTE

**The ear marked funding for specialty training will go on**

- Supports quality of education
- **Goes to universities, too**
- **Goes to private sector, too**
- Goes only to those organisations committed to continuous quality assurance
- Money follows the trainee

# Compensation of specialty training

## Payment for arranging education

- Esim. alueellinen erikoistuvien määrään ja tarvearvio
- Edellytyksenä yliopiston kanssa tehty koulutus sopimus.
- Sopimus sisältää mm. koulutukseen osallistuvien palveluntuottajien määrittelyn yhdessä yliopiston kanssa

## Payment for organising the education

- Sopimus koulutuksen järjestämisestä ja palveluntuottajien käytöstä sekä yo:n saamasta rahoituksesta
- Sopimuksen minimisisältö määritellään asetuksessa
