# Funding the specialty training in health centres

## Today

 A public provider (a single local municipality or joint authority) gets from the state about 1000 €/trainee/month compensating the work force loss of the trainee, because she/he is not treating patients, but attending education.

### The course of money

- In order to be accepted as a training health centre, the health centre must share that sum of money (75 % - 25 %) with the Primary Care Unit (PCU) of the local university hospital.
- PCU has a network covering its area for facilitating and assessing specialty training
- The goals of training and the methods/content of training is set by university.

### **Problems**

- Only public health centres are accepted
- The universities have the responsibility but no money at all

# The ear marked funding for specialty training will go on


- Supports quality of education
